Human Services Announces Temporary Closure Mars Hill Office due to lack of running water at facilities

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS - The Virgin Islands Department of Human Services (VIDHS), is advising the community that due to WAPA water pump issues affecting the town of Frederiksted, St. Croix the DHS Mars Hill Administrative Building and DHS Senior Citizen Affairs Administration Office, both located at Mars Hill, Frederiksted will be closing this afternoon, Wednesday, October 18, 2023 at 2:00 pm due to a lack of running water at the facilities.
