MEDICAID PROGRAM PUBLIC NOTICE REIMBURSEMENT FOR ADDING TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT AND RELATED REIMBURSEMENT METHODOLOGY

December 30, 2024

As required by 42 CFR 447.205, the Department of Human Services (DHS) is providing this public notice of the proposed addition of Medicaid reimbursement methodology for targeted case management (TCM) as required by Section 5121 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 (Section 5121). Section 5121 requires the provision of pre- and post-release TCM for eligible juveniles who are incarcerated.

The proposed methodology would reimburse providers using the procedure codes and rates identified in the USVI Medicaid Fee Schedule. The annual aggregate expenditure for this new service is expected to be \$15,000.

USVI proposes to make the amendment effective on or after January 1, 2025. USVI expects to submit the State Plan Amendment (SPA) to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) by March 31, 2025. Implementation of this change depends on approval by CMS.
